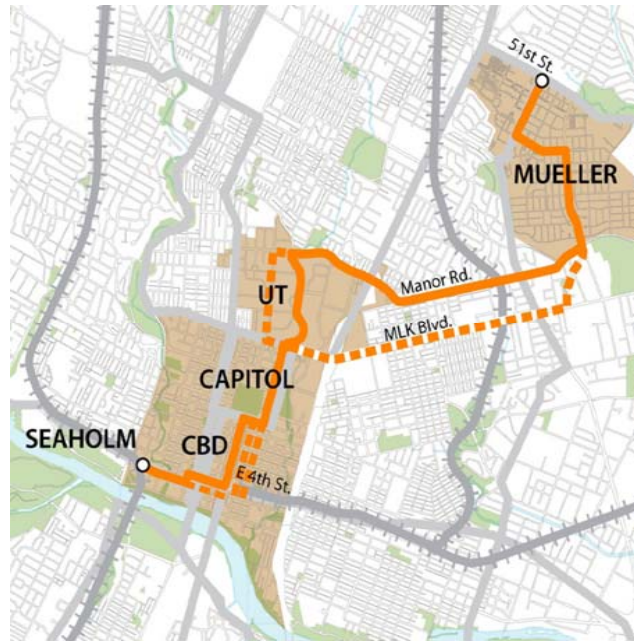
9/25/08 | UT Earth Summit
